

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR EMT-BASIC CLASS

1. Location of Classes:
MOB= Ambulatory Care Facility at Perry Memorial Hospital, 4th floor. Any other changes will be as announced.
2. All classes will begin at 6:00 P.M. unless announced differently. Classes will end at approximately 10:00 P.M. Class days vary according to the schedule.
3. Class schedule and location are subject to change in case of emergency.
4. No more than 2 classes may be missed. Should you have a schedule conflict, please contact Deb.
5. None of these exams may be missed.
6. There are eight written quizzes and a final written exam. You may have one re-take for up to three of the eight exams, but no retakes are permitted for the final exam. Your score on retake must be 90%. Passing score on quizzes is 80%.
7. The workbook assignments are an important part of your study for the class. They must be completed for each chapter and are due to the instructor each week on the first class day of the week.
8. A grade of 80 is considered passing. This grade is based on your exam scores. Workbook assignments and practical exam are pass / fail.
9. Each student must schedule and complete 20 hours of Emergency Department clinical experience and submit the clinical experience worksheet to the class coordinator before writing the final exam. Clinical experience must be completed before the final written exam.
